St. Mary's Axe, London

Stone Type: Granite

Known as "The Gherkin", this is one of the most recognisable buildings recently constructed in the centre of London.

Although the main building is predominantly glass, Stirling Stone undertook substantial granite works at various levels. Polished grey granite was extensively used in the ground floor reception area and lift lobbies.

Externally, large areas of granite paving were laid around the base of the building, along with landscaping features. The main ramp walls leading towards the underground car park were also clad in granite.
