

Featured Project: Gurdwara Temple, London



Stone Type: Limestone, Granite

This magnificent building in Southall is the largest Sikh temple outside India. Extensively clad in limestone, the temple has many interesting stone details including heavy ornate arches, minarets and granite columns to the main entrance. The building dominates the Southall skyline with the gold dome's ornate architecture.

The project won the Ealing Civic Trust Award in 2003.
