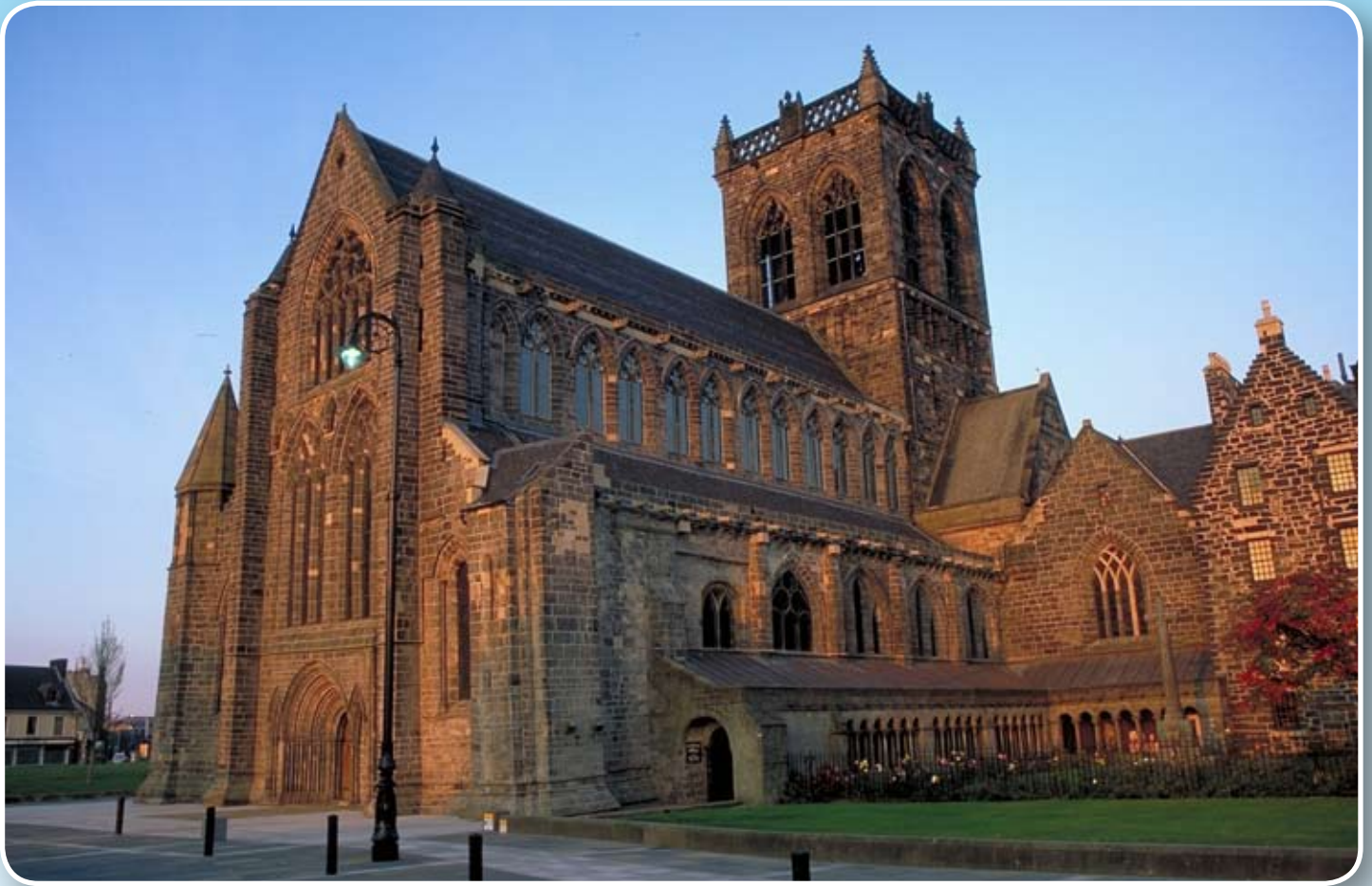


Featured Project: Paisley Abbey, Glasgow



Stone Type: Sandstone

Stirling Stone was the main contractor on various phases of the ongoing restoration of this 14th century abbey. Stonemasonry work included the repointing of the whole tower, rebuilding parapet walls and replacing badly eroded stone gutters and gargoyles.

Other subtrades such as slate work, lead work and timber repairs were carried out under our site management. A condition of the contract was that the church remained in use at all times, and special measures were implemented for public safety.
