Pitsligo Road, Edinburgh

Stone Type: Sandstone

A high specification private residential development in the Merchiston conservation area of Edinburgh, this contemporary design compliments well with neighbouring architecture.

The subtle use of differing textural variations of natural buff sandstone on the main elevations mimics the stone buildings of Edinburgh. These textures included three different types of finish on the stone walling: pitched face walling, rusticated smooth ashlar and sandblasted distressed walls to the projecting balcony features.

The development won a Craft of Excellence Award for its stonework from the Scottish Building - Edinburgh and District Association in 2007.
