



## Featured Project: Sheriff Courthouse, Edinburgh

**Stone Type: Sandstone, Granite**

With an overall value of more than £6.5m this is one of the largest stone masonry contracts in the UK since the Second World War. The main external façade, including the ground floor arched colonnade, is in buff sandstone. The main wall areas are in a split faced sandstone, while the dressings are a smooth ashlar finish.

Further extensive external works were undertaken, including steps, paving and other landscape features. Internally, the large full height public atrium which connects all the court levels was also given the natural stone treatment, with most of the walls clad in buff sandstone and granite floors and staircases. This project won Natural Stone Awards for both "New Build" and "Interiors" categories.
